Kimberly Martinez recently joined Dispute Mediation Service after serving 10 years as a Master Child Advocate on a Child Fatality Team and Sexual Assault Response Team for abused children. After graduating from Texas State University in 1987, she began her work in negotiation and alternative dispute resolution (ADR) with American Arbitration Association in Dallas and Houston, Texas. She also worked for JAMS and Association of Attorney Mediators throughout her initial ADR career. Kimberly was a member of one of the first classes of SMU's Graduate Marketing Certificate Program in 1993 and continued her graduate work at SMU until 1995 where she met and then married, Frank her husband.

During her ADR career, she had the privilege of training over 2,000 lawyers, insurance adjusters and business professionals on negotiations and "the benefits and how to" of ADR processes.
