Peter L. Stavinoha, Ph.D., is a licensed psychologist with specialized training and experience in neuropsychology with children and adolescents. He directs the neuropsychology service at Children's Medical Center of Dallas, and he is Associate Professor of Psychiatry at the University of Texas Southwestern Medical School.

Dr. Stavinoha has extensive training and experience evaluating the neurocognitive, educational, social, and emotional aspects of a variety of developmental disabilities, learning issues, disruptive behavior disorders, brain injuries, and other neurological conditions.

Dr. Stavinoha was named ***Distinguished Psychologist for 2005*** by the Dallas Psychological Association. He has lectured extensively on topics including ADHD, dyslexia, learning disabilities, autism and pervasive developmental disorder, traumatic brain injury, the effects of childhood cancer on learning and behavior, the effects of epilepsy on learning and behavior, brain development in children, and general parenting. Dr. Stavinoha is a member of the American Psychological Association, the International Neuropsychological Society, and the Texas Psychological Association.

Dr. Stavinoha received his B.A. in Psychology from the University of Notre Dame. He received his Ph.D. in Educational Psychology (School Psychology) from the University of Texas. Dr. Stavinoha's Postdoctoral Fellowship in Clinical Neuropsychology was at the Medical College of Wisconsin
